Complete the application form. **Make check (NO CASH) payable to “MOGA”** and drop in the MOGA box in the computer room at the Oakwood Pro Shop (**remember to include your GHIN** & LOCAL** (number)**). If you are paying before Nov 1, 2016, please date your check 1 Nov 2016.

NEW FULL MOGA MEMBERS WITHOUT AN ESTABLISHED HANDICAP:

- Complete the application form per the above payment options.
- Include 5 attested scores (from any course) with the date, course slope and rating.
You must have at least ***5 scores to establish a “trend” handicap to play on Men’s Day.
*** **Not applicable to Handicap only members**
- Attach check ONLY, (NO cash) with form and five (5) **dated & attested scorecards** and drop in MOGA box in computer room by the Pro Shop.
- New members who enroll for 2017 MOGA play will be eligible to play in 2016 as soon as their application is processed.

****NOTE** If a member belongs to more than 1 club, he must pay full AGA Membership dues to all clubs he is a member of. Individual members can request a rebate from AGA for the additional clubs (except for 1) and will receive a rebate from AGA for the payment. AGA will hold \$15 for each additional club a member belongs to.**



NEW FOR 2016

The Arizona Golf Association and Arizona Women’s Golf Association will continue to offer a Multi-Member Rebate Program for any members who belong to more than one club in the state of Arizona. However, beginning in 2016 the associations will no longer offer full rebates. The membership dues for each additional club joined will be \$15.

Beginning January 1, 2016, membership and rebate policies will be as follows:

- **Member Dues:** Individuals are required to pay full AGA/AWGA member fees to *each* of their Arizona clubs.
- **Club Billings:** Clubs will be required to pay full member fees for each activated player on their roster at the time of association billing, regardless if the player is also a member of another club.
- **Eligible Memberships:**
 - Only club memberships activated prior to July 1 will be eligible for a rebate, as memberships activated after that date are at a prorated amount.
 - A member who belongs to a 9 Hole Club and an 18 Hole Club is not considered a multiple member and is not eligible for a rebate for either membership.
- **Rebate Requests:** Rebate requests may *only* be submitted by the individual member, either online or by mail between January 1 - December 1.
- **Rebate Payments:** Rebate checks will be issued beginning July 1, provided full payment has been received from each of the member’s active clubs. This is to maximize time for all clubs to remit payment on invoices.
- **Online Options: (AGA Clubs only)** If an individual joins multiple clubs that all utilize the online signup program, the rebate will be handled immediately upon signup.

Reason for changes: There are a few reasons for this change. There are hard costs associated with the administration of every club in our membership (including course rating, score posting equipment, software and support, seminars and educational programs) which are not being covered at clubs with high levels of multi-members. Also, club administrators are being tasked with managing the additional club memberships and payments, which is time consuming and inefficient at both the local and association level. This change is intended to apply the costs back to those relatively few members who participate at multiple clubs rather than spreading the cost over the entire membership.
