



MOGA Minutes May 1, 2018

Meeting was called to order at 8:30 AM by President Doug Braun

Craig moved the April minutes be approved. Aki seconded. Passed.

**Treasurer's Report:** Craig reported April deposits of \$2,602.00 and expenses of \$3,658.59. The month end bank balance was \$9,641.36. Year to date deposits totaled \$59,005.00 with YTD expenses totaling \$47,224.32. Craig also reported that he will be selling MOGA shirts and hats at future MOGA events.

**Membership Report:** Wayne reported that 2 full and 1 handicap only member joined in April bringing the total membership to 267 full memberships and 95 handicap only members. Wayne is looking into having the AGA collect MOGA and AGA dues in the future as many of the clubs have already done. There are a few areas of concern with moving forward so he will have some questions answered and will report back to the board at the October meeting.

**Tournament Director Report:** Dan reported that the Cottonwood home and home was a bust and that we should consider dropping the event in the future. The Member/Member held on April 19 was a success with 84 players participating. There have been 1521 rounds played in MOGA events through April with over 45% of the players receiving chits. A MOGA/OLGA mixer event is being scheduled for next year. It was suggested that the two clubs take turns hosting the event. The host organization will determine the format.

**New Business:** Craig moved that the MOGA fiscal year be changed from November 1-October 31 to January 1-December 31. Dan Muth seconded. Motion carried. No decision was made regarding the need for the club to purchase a computer. The 2018-2019 schedule of events will be made at the October meeting. Wayne is updating the member handbook. Player conduct during MOGA events was discussed. Everyone agreed that improper conduct will not be tolerated, and the offending player will be banned from future MOGA events. A club meeting will be held in the fall to acquaint all members with the rule changes taking effect in 2019. The Ironwood clubhouse will be closing at 3:00 beginning May 1 and the Oakwood clubhouse will be closing at 2:00 beginning June 1.
