



MOGA Minutes September 18, 2018

Meeting was called to order at 2:30 PM by President Doug Braun

**Treasures Report:** Craig reported that the balance in our checking account was \$5,569.94. All bills have been paid to date. He reported that the balance should easily get us through the remainder of the fiscal year.

**Membership Report:** Wayne reported that 12 new members have joined since our meeting in May. That brings the total MOGA membership to 373 of which 97 are handicap only and 276 hold full memberships. 20 of our members reside outside of IronOaks.

**Tournament Director Report:** Dan M. reported that he is getting great help from the pro shop. He extended his thanks to Eddie and Kevin for stepping up. The summer tournament has for the most part been well received. Some PM players would like to see games other than individual events but the low number of players prevents that from happening.

**President's Report:** Doug asked all board members to review the 2018-2019 tournament schedule prior to the October meeting. The schedule will be finalized at that time. There will be a Robson Challenge golf tournament at Saddletree in Tucson on November 14<sup>th</sup>. Cost is \$50 per player. MOGA will be represented at the event. Details are being worked out. It will be an ABC tournament. Doug said he would be looking for a member to step up and assume the VP position for next year.

**New Business:** Dan B. reported that it had been decided that the club does not have to purchase a new computer since everything is pretty much web and cloud based. Some members have been taking advantage of the free drink day. The intent of the day is to encourage members to stick around and have a beverage or two and engage in fellowship. A letter will be going out over the Board's signature asking members to heed these guidelines. A discussion was held

regarding members to renew their memberships on-line through the AGA. Members could use their credit cards to renew. Craig made a motion that for next year members can choose between renewing on-line through the AGA or with a paper application with a check as in the past. Full dues to be \$125 but if paid before December 15 dues would be \$120. Handicap only dues to be \$65 but \$60 if paid before December 15. Aki seconded. Motion carried.

Aki moved we adjourn. Wayne seconded Meeting was adjourned.
